

Accommodation Options:

We have researched a number of accommodation options on behalf of the students, and are constantly refreshing this research to provide more. At the moment we have the following:

1. HOME STAY accommodation can be arranged through a company we are dealing with, who currently supply a large number of the Thames Valley University students, and come highly recommended by the University Accommodation office.

All rooms are checked beforehand by the company for comfort and quality. Not all families that apply to offer accommodation are accepted. Reviews of the families are carried out and the company also acts as mediators between the family and guest. They currently have about 120+ families operational on the database.

The rates to families for students start from £110- £115.00 per week to include bed, breakfast and evening meals plus bedding, laundry and all bills. 2. A company called STUDENT STREET offer a website service, which is currently free of charge. On the site, students can search and overview rooms available, and also upload their basic profile needs. The site aims to match the student's needs with an available room or place to rent. They are not Estate Agents and offer purely a search and match service. They currently supply students attending Thames Valley University, London Reading College, University of Reading, Impact International and Henley Business School.
